INSTRUCTORS

Seth Cimino is employed with the Citrus Heights Police Department (CHPD) where he is assigned to the patrol division. He recently transferred to the CHPD after spending over 11 years with the Del Norte Co. Sheriff's Office. During his career Seth has spent over 7 1/2 years as a narcotics detective / K9 Handler. His focus of investigation was marijuana related crimes, to include: indoor and outdoor MJ investigations and Prop. 215 marijuana possession, cultivation, transportation and sales cases. He has been involved in the investigations of several hundred drug related crimes. Seth has also qualified in State court as an expert in marijuana possession, possession for sales, cultivation, transportation, sales and medical marijuana case law and application.

Rick Dooley graduated magna cum laude in 1994 from Western State University College of Law where he was an associate editor of the Law Review. He served as an extern to Justice Henry T. Moore of the California Court of Appeals prior to joining an Orange County business litigation firm as an associate attorney. His five year tenure with this law firm included two published appellate court opinions, one state and one federal. He joined the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office in 1999 and is currently assigned to the Major Narcotics Division as the office's medical marijuana coordinator.
